6 The Canvassing Board of Lake Hamilton held a meeting on Tuesday, April 1, 2014 at Town Hall, Clerk's  
7 Office located at 100 Smith Avenue, Lake Hamilton, FL 33851.

8 **CALL TO ORDER:** Clerk Irvine called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

9 **ROLL CALL:** Clerk Irvine, Tomlinson, Kehoe and Town Attorney Christman.

10 **Appoint Chair/Vice Chair:**

11 **MOTION by Tomlinson/Irvine to appoint Kehoe as Chair.**

12 **MOTION by Kehoe/Irvine to appoint Tomlinson as Vice Chair.**

13 **CANVASS ABSENTEE BALLOTS:** Irvine reported that she and Kehoe picked up the absentee ballots from  
14 Supervisor of Elections (SOE) and there were 85 absentee ballots. There was one signature that Clerk  
15 Irvine was unable to verify. She noted that the signature was Mildred Tomlinson and that Mr. Tomlinson  
16 would have to recuse himself from reviewing the signature. Attorney Christman provided him with from  
17 8B Memorandum of Voting Conflict for County, Municipal, and other Local Public Officers to file with the  
18 Clerk. Kehoe and Irvine reviewed the signature with the signature documents provided by the SOE.  
19 Kehoe and Irvine approve the signature based on the information provided.

20 **MOTION Kehoe/Tomlinson to accept the absentee ballots that were reviewed by the Clerk and begin**  
21 **processing the ballots for canvassing. All voted in favor.**

22 Clerk Irvine opened the envelopes and removed the ballots from the secrecy sleeve and shuffled the  
23 ballots.

24 Chair Kehoe called for a recess at 5:53 PM.

25 Chair Kehoe reconvened the meeting at 7:48 PM.

26 The Board canvassed the absentee ballots by having Tomlinson read off the names voted for and Irvine  
27 marking them on the tally sheet and Kehoe verifying.

28 The following are the results of the Absentee Ballot Canvass:

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38 Total number of ballots canvassed were 85 and it was noted that two ballots only voted for one seat.
